Learn to Program With the Arduino

Fort Collins, Colorado -- August 2014 -- The newly-launched Fort Collins Creator Hub presents their first public workshop, "Introduction to Arduino", on Saturday, Aug. 23rd.

What's an Arduino? An Arduino is a credit-card sized easily programmable computer that interacts with the real world based on your commands. Its uses are only limited to your imagination! You don't have to be an electrical engineer or computer scientist to create a project around this user-friendly board.

This workshop will cover basic electrical circuits, features of the Arduino Uno, the Arduino programming environment, and a set of staged projects using the Arduino. By the end of the class, you should be comfortable building basic circuits and programming the Arduino. The Creator Hub will supply all materials and computers required for this workshop. There is room for 15 participants. Two people can share one computer and

Arduino - but only one should sign up. All ages are welcome, but those under 12 must register with a parent or guardian.

This workshop will be held at the Fort Collins Harmony Library from noon to 3pm.
